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


BACKGROUND

Directorate General for students (MI), integration and participation has started various activities and collaborations over the years, aimed at schools of all levels, to protect the right to health, raise awareness on prevention issues and promote correct styles of life.

In February 2019 the memorandum of understanding with the Ministry of Health was renewed and the document that integrates what has already been defined was renewed.

The focus of the research is to define a plan of interventions aimed at students, their families and school staff, with the aim of building individual skills on the issues of health promotion, of qualifying the environments in which young people learn. In respect of autonomy, with the support of a regional network, each school will be able to structure paths for the psychophysical well-being of children and young people, work to improve the quality of study places, promote healthy lifestyles such as, for example, eating healthy and doing physical activity.





Formalized the regional convention with five-year validity signed on 01/08/2022 between the Tuscany Region and the Regional School Office aimed at integrated governance for the development of the model referred to in the document "Integrated guidelines for schools that promote health"



Ensure that the monitoring systems of the education sector consider health promotion as an integral part of school life, and that this is reflected in their control indicators

Presence of a regional network of "schools that promote health" formalized by the regional school office of Tuscany

Establishing an HPS is not a time-limited project. It is a process of change, development and evolution that builds a healthy school community. However, not everything can be changed on the spot and if the goals and strategies are realistic, substantial changes can occur in 3-4 years.

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
